Facts about your entry for judges: _____

A “drop-off lane” will be open for anyone dropping off participants. Please follow signage and drive slowly in the staging area.

Maintain 15'-20' between entries during the parade. Should you fall behind, safely increase your speed to keep up with the group in front of you.

Please utilize horns modestly so that all entries can be heard.

All performances before the judges must be kept to 90 seconds.

Your entry will be pre-assigned a lane for staging. Please follow directions given by parade volunteer upon arrival. Your entry will also be assigned a number that is to be placed on your window for identification. Make sure the judges can see your ID Number during your presentation.

Parade entry fee of \$20 must be submitted with registration form.
Late entry fee is \$25.

STAGING AREA OPENS AT 1 PM AT THE CORNER OF FRONT & 8TH STREET.

Trophy presentations will be made immediately after the parade.
