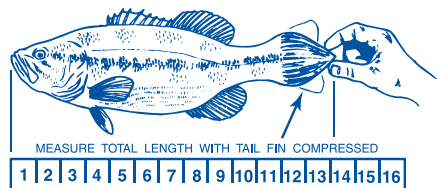

Tournament Rules

All Reds, Specks, Bass, Flounder, Catfish, White Perch and Sunfish (Perch) will become the property of the OCARC Fishing Tournament.

No Gar. No Rough Fish. No Gafftops.

I. ELIGIBILITY:

- A. Anyone other than professional Fisherman (this includes anyone who derives 60% of their income from fishing).
- B. This is an open tournament. Each person in the boat over sixteen (16) must be a paid contestant of this tournament. Each contestant is responsible for their own catch. This is not a draw tournament.
- C. Participants sixteen (16) years or younger fish free, must be accompanied by a parent or other adult entered in the tournament and must have entry on file to weigh in a fish.

II. REGISTRATION AND ENTRY FEE:

- A. Fishing entries accepted to August 4th, 2023 until 5:00 p.m.
- B. Regular entry will be **\$30.00** per person for the tournament

III. SAFETY:

- A. All State, Coast Guard, Federal and Parks & Wildlife regulations shall apply at all times.
- B. The tournament will be held weather and conditions permitting (should conditions threaten safety, please use all caution!!).

IV. PERMITTED FISHING AREAS & HOURS:

- A. Fishing area open to the general public. Fresh water fish 40 mile radius of Orange.
- B. No private ponds or lakes.
- C. Hours will be 5:00 p.m. Friday, August 4th to **5:00 pm**, Saturday, August 5th, 2023.

V. TACKLE AND EQUIPMENT NOT ALLOWED:

- A. Dynamite, electronic stunning devices, telephones and **NO NETS OF ANY KIND** (with the exception of DIP NETS). No bow fishing.
- B. All fish must conform to Texas Parks & Wildlife regulations for size and limits – **NO** Louisiana legal size fish will be weighed if different from Texas legal size.

VI. WEIGH-INS:

- A. City of Orange Boat Ramp.
- B. This is a big fish tournament.
- C. All entries with fish to be weighed in must have weigh-in registration ticket in their possession by **5:00 pm** Saturday, August 5th. Certification of fish begins at **3:00 pm**.
- D. Weigh-ins for all tournament fish (bass, redfish, speckled trout, flounder, catfish, grinnel, mudcat, white perch, croaker, black drum, sunfish (perch) – any other fish) will begin Saturday, August 5th, 2023 at **5:00 pm**.
- E. We must have application form on file.
- F. Lie detector test can be used.
- G. Contestants can only win one place per category.
- H. Red Fish must be between 20" and 27" in length.
- I. Black Drum must be between 14" and 29" in length.
- J. All fish will be examined before weigh-in. No frozen, mutilated or inedible fish will be accepted for weigh-in.
- K. All fish will remain in weigh-in area after being examined.
- ➔ **L. Bass must be alive.**

VII. DECISIONS:

- A. All decisions of the Tournament Director are final.
- B. **ALL PROTESTS** must be registered in writing with the Tournament Director within thirty (30) minutes of designated weigh-ins.
